- ~ Cooperate with related regional and national organizations such as the National Flute Association

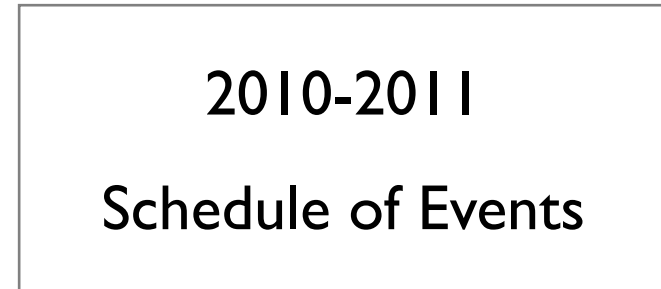
Membership Information
